Pet Owners

We would like to remind all pet owners to clean up after their pets. Be sure to bring baggies when walking your dog. Dogs must also be kept on a leash and under control at all times (city code)



Parties

Several units have continued to ignore the Association's rules on parties. Heavy fines are being imposed for any infraction plus fees for any debris that has to be picked up. This also applies to those units making excessive noise at any time. Please take a moment to review the following party rules:

- Advise your neighbors
- Ensure your guests remain inside of your home (not in common areas or streets)
- Keep windows & doors closed to contain the noise level and bring people in from the patio
- NO pool parties without Management's approval
- Adhere to the pool hours listed
- City Code states "no noise after 10:00 p.m. Sunday-Thursday, 12:00 a.m. Friday & Saturday
- SDPD and San Diego Patrol will be called! Homeowners are on record for charges pressed against them, which may result in fines & arrests

CAPP is available now for Residents affected by the noise. When police are called out to the property be sure to get incident #'s.

Slab Leaks

The Association has had some recent slab leaks which affected several units. If you think you may have a slab leak please contact The Management Company immediately.

Signs of slab leaks are warm spots on the floor or a sudden increase in your monthly electric bill.





Rat Problem

Rodents like to go inside for warmth. You can help prevent this from happening in your unit by making sure your garbage cans are kept closed and taken out for pick-up each week.

If you suspect you have a problem please contact the Management Company so a bait station may be placed by your home.

Reminders.....

- Satellite dish wires should not be exposed on the outside; if you need an Architectural Application, please contact Management
- If you noticed that your electric bill has increased, running water noise or feel a hot spot on the floor, call management immediately
- Please check your dryer vents inside & outside
- Please change your battery in your fire alarms
- Please keep screen doors closed at all times. ***If they are broken repair them or replace them***
- **No washing of cars at any time** on Playmor Terrace's property
- **NO** towels, wetsuits, **NOTHING** over fences or balcony rails - fines will be imposed
- If you notice a possible abandoned car, please call vehicle abatement at 858-495-7856 and Management at 619-233-0553
